At the oche

- Games start at the scheduled time (men at 11 AM and women at 13 PM). After a game, there is a break for 7 minutes but then the next game should start. Let's show respect to the opponents and show up on time at the oche.
- 6 practice darts are allowed to warm up before a game is announced on.
- All kinds of fuss and noise should be restricted throughout the game.
- It is not permitted to tell the competitor what numbers to throw at. Not by markers, competitors nor spectators.
- The tournament committee does not pick up or call competitors to the line, each competitor is responsible for appearing on the line on time.
- The one who does not show up at the oche on time automatically forfeits the game.

Riðlar

- The former on the Round Robin sheet starts to bull.
- The competitors dart that is closest to the bull starts the game.
- After 45 darts thrown, the game shall be finished by a bull throw.
- If it occurs in a game that the marker enters incorrect numbers, the marker must be corrected before the competitor throws back into the dartboard after his opponent.
- A competitor who loses a game must write the next game before he / she leaves.
